Payments are accepted in Cash, Credit Card (via PayPal) or Check. Payment of the registration fee plus \$100 per class will hold your space in class. Full payment is due by the first class. If you need a payment plan you may arrange this through our bookkeeper, Debbie Miller. An additional charge (equal to our late charge) will be added to payment plans.

STUDIO INFORMATION, PRICING AND POLICIES

Registration Fee (annual) \$25 per person or \$35 per family. *Please add the registration fee to the prices below.*

All classes will prepare choreography for the recital except classes that are listed on the schedule as non-performing. Performing is optional for adults who are taking classes that are preparing recital choreography.

A mandatory recital fee of \$50 will be charged each non-adult student. This fee is due with your registration fee and tuition. The fee will act as a costume deposit and will go towards recital costume fees. This fee is not refundable.

Class Pricing (per semester) except as noted

- One 45 minute primary or pre-ballet class per week - \$210
- One class hour per week - \$245
- Additional class hours per week - \$225
- *Additional half hour or quarter hour classes per week will be charged at the \$225 per hour rate*
- Workshop Program (unlimited ballet & pointe classes) - \$895
- Private Coaching - \$80 per hour, \$45 per half hour
- Tippi Toes (7 week session, no registration fee) - \$90
- Price Cap per Person -- \$1275 (includes ballet and other styles of dance)

Single Class (adults only with the permission of instructor)

one hour class - \$17.50

one and a half hour class - \$25

No registration fee for adults

Adults only seven hour card - \$105.00 (usable in any appropriate class)

Please note - If the first member of a family is taking three or more class hours per week, the second and third members of a family will receive a 10% discount on all classes.

Registration form, Registration Fee and \$100 tuition deposit per class is due to hold your space in class. For the Workshop Program the Registration Fee plus a \$500 deposit is required.

All fees are non-refundable.

Balance of tuition for the Semester is due by the first week of class. A \$15 late fee will be charged for payments received after the first week of class. Checks should be made payable to Ballet Durango and include your child's full name in the memo. Payment plans can be arranged. There will be a fee equal to the late fee charged to set up a payment plan. There is a \$15

returned check fee per check on all returned checks. Tuition remains the same regardless of absences.

Bad Weather / Holidays - The studio will close for the day if Durango 9R closes for snow. We may also close if the roads get bad during the day.
