

Safety Protocol for the Ballet Durango —

- Students will be met before entering the studio by a representative of Ballet Durango, and they should be wearing a mask. Your temperature will be taken. If you are not feeling well or have a temperature please do not come in the studio.
- Student and family will be asked questions concerning possible symptoms and/or exposure to Covid-19. If you think you might have been exposed to Covid-19 go home and self isolate as directed by authorities.
- Students should be wearing their mask at all times when they are in the studio except as noted below.
- Parents will not come in the studio unless it is necessary. Parents of small children can come into the studio and then if possible leave the building and wait in your car. We would like to reduce the number of people in the studio.
- Students will go directly to their studio. Nobody will hang out in the hallway at any time. If possible students should come dressed for class. Do not change clothes at the studio if you can avoid it.
- Everything that you bring into the studio should be in your dance bag and kept there. The dance bag will go with you into the studio or put in one of the cubbies.
- Students will bring a water bottle (in the dance bag).
- The only time students will leave their studio is to use the bathroom. Ask for permission to leave for this purpose. Masks should remain on for this process.
- Class size will be limited and dancers will be separated throughout class. Please stay socially distanced whenever you are in the building.
- Masks will be required at all times. The ones that Tiffany has made are made from a very breathable material that is also very effective in terms of filtration. When drinking or eating they should be slipped down around your neck — not removed. That keeps them from inadvertently being dropped onto the floor. These masks can be disinfected by placing them in a 180 degree oven for 20 minutes. Do not put them in the washing machine as they will disintegrate. Instructions for disinfecting will be included in the bag they come in.
- Pre-ballet students should wear a mask into the studio. Then they can hang it on one of the hooks provided in the studio.
- The only time masks should be removed is when a student is sitting or standing at their designated spot at the barre to have a drink of water. Remember — don't actually remove them. Slip them down around your neck.
- When you use the bathroom wash your hands thoroughly. Use a paper towel to turn off the faucet and open the door, then discard it in the hallway trash can.
- We have hand sanitizer — use it often.
- The studio is thoroughly cleaned and disinfected often. All barres and other touched surfaces will be disinfected throughout the day.
